

Floyd County Conservation Club Scholarship # 2

Amount: \$1000

Purpose: To provide financial assistance to qualified adults in Indiana or Kentucky to further their training/education

Eligibility: Open to Floyd County Conservation Club members, their spouses, children, or grandchildren who are at least 19 years of age and have been out of high school for one or more years and whose primary residence is located in the state of Indiana or Kentucky

Terms of Award: The funds shall be payable only to The Educational Institution that the Scholarship recipient will be attending in the following fall/spring, and may be used for undergraduate, graduate or trade/volitional school Tuition, textbooks or other instructional materials, room & board expenses.

Recipient may receive this award only ONCE in his/her lifetime.

How to Apply: Each applicant must submit the following:

1. Completed Application
2. Copy of High School diploma or GE
3. Transcript of all college courses completed, if any
4. Certificate of completion for any other training/courses, if applicable
5. Letter of intent describing the following: Course of study, plans for completion of this course of study, and what this means to me

Deadline: Submit application, copy of high school diploma/GED, transcripts, certificates and letter of intent
