

Floyd County Conservation Club Scholarship # 1

Amount: \$1000

Purpose: To provide financial assistance to qualified students in Indiana or Kentucky to further their training/education

Eligibility: Open to graduating high school seniors (including home schooled students) who are a Floyd County Conservation Club (FCCC) member's child or grandchild who has resided in the State of Indiana or Kentucky for at least 24 months prior to their high school graduation date and has a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher

Terms of Award: The funds shall be payable only to The Educational Institution that the Scholarship recipient will be attending in the fall following their high school graduation and may be used for undergraduate or trade/volitional school Tuition, textbooks or other instructional materials, room & board expenses.

Recipient may receive this award ONCE in his/her lifetime.

How to Apply: Each applicant must submit the following:

1. Completed Application
2. Essay (200 -500 words) on the following: Why do you agree or disagree with the Second Amendment of The Constitution of the United States of America?
3. (2) Letters of Recommendation from an adult that is not a relative
4. A copy of your current High School Transcript
